

Implant Dentistry Year Course

with Dr Fazeela Khan-Osborne and Dr Neil Cooper

The Face Team's Implantology Year Programme trains and equips the general dental practitioner to carry out surgical and restorative implant procedures in a predictable way, providing excellent long-term aesthetic results for their patients.

The course is a comprehensive practical evidence based programme, with half of the teaching time delivered as live surgery and prosthetics. Training is provided by a team of experienced implant practitioners from the UK and around the world, in dedicated teaching facilities in central London.

The programme provides 20 days of training over a period of approximately 10 months, and meets the required educational criteria for 140 hours of CPD. In addition to the team leaders, Dr Fazeela Khan-Osborne and Dr Neil Cooper, other invited speakers lecture throughout the course.
